\*The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Insolvency Resolution Process for Corporate Persons) (Third Amendment) Regulations, 2020, notification dated March 29, 2020, inserted new Regulation 40C, the relevant portion reads as "Not with standing the time-lines contained in these regulations, but subject to the provisions in the Code, the period of lockdown imposed by the Central & State Government in the wake of COVID-19 outbreak shall not be counted for the purposes of the time-line for any activity that could not be completed due to such lockdown, in relation to a corporate Insolvency Resolution Process"

The Hon'ble NCLAT taking suo moto cognizance of the unprecedented situation arising out of spread of COVID19, passed the order dated March 30, 2020 inter alia stating that the period of lockdown ordered by the Central Government and the State Governments including the period as may be extended either in whole or part of the country, where the registered office of the Corporate Debtor may be located, shall be excluded for the purpose of counting of the period for Resolution Process under Section 12 of the Code, in all cases where 'Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process' has been initiated and pending before any Bench of the National Company Law Tribunal or in Appeal before this Appellate Tribunal.

The above timelines are, inter alia, based on the lockdown ordered currently till July 31, 2020 by the state government of Maharashtra. The same are subject to further revision on approval of CoC depending upon any further order/directions on lockdown by the government on account of pandemic Covid-19 read with Regulation 40C of CIRP Regulations.

The above timelines are subject to NCLT Mumbai granting the exclusion of time period in receipt of the order.
